Re: Pontoon at Clump Point Boat Ramp

We confirm our discussion at the Association meeting on the 5th June in that we lend our whole-hearted support to the provision of an access pontoon to assist with the launch and retrieval of trailer boats at the Clump Point boat ramp.

We confirm the ramp design already incorporates on it's left hand side [looking west-north-westward] the access for a small pontoon to extend within the breakwater area.

We have been dealing at length with Maritime Safety Queensland in relation to our overall marine facility and this pontoon, provided it meets with Australian Design Standards and Maritime Safety requirements, would be able to be incorporated into the final project at Mission Cove.

Anything further we can do to support this improvement to local maritime infrastructure at Mission Beach will be readily undertaken on behalf of the association.

You are authorised to use this letter as evidence of our support for the pontoon as an immediate short-term improvement to the current facilities which we acknowledge are inadequate in their present state.

Thank you for your letter of 28 February 2007 and the discussions held at the Community Cabinet meeting of 11 February 2007 with the Honourable Andrew Fraser MP, Minister for Local Government, Planning and Sport, regarding the Mission Beach divisional local government boundaries, including a request that the matter be referred to the Electoral Commissioner of Queensland.

The Minister has asked me to respond on his behalf.

As you are aware, on 15 May 2007, Minister Fraser wrote to Mr Warwick Jull, President of the Mission Beach Community Association advising that the previous correspondence from the Association has been forwarded to the Local Government Reform Commission (the LGRC) for its consideration.

The opportunity to resolve the divided boundary issues affecting Mission Beach will now be dealt with by the LGRC who will announce their findings publicly in early August 2007.
